In 2001, while in high school, I learned about the need for foster families through my church. I wanted my mom to be a foster parent but my father had recently died and we weren't in a place to take that on. I continued to have the desire on my heart to support these children throughout my life and even started the process twice but had to put it on hold both times due to changing circumstances. I finally had the opportunity to complete certification with Agape in the fall of 2021. I was married and our



three daughters were 13, 10 and 7. We were nervous but after all the training and soaking up the information and wisdom from the Agape staff, we felt ready and so supported. Although we knew we would be meeting these children during some of the toughest days of their lives, we looked forward to welcoming them into our family and doing our best to make the process as easy as possible for them. We knew we would fall in love with every child but we wanted to support reunification first and foremost. Because of this, we didn't have plans to adopt but our hearts were open to the possibility.

We said yes to 2 different sibling sets but they ended up getting placed elsewhere. Our next call was on December 6, 2021, and this time we got to receive our first placement, a precious 6 week old baby boy. I had always wanted a son so it felt surreal to be able to have him in my care and experience the baby stage again. I looked forward to meeting his mom and trying to be an encouragement to her. She ended up being unable to work her case plan so his case was moved to adoptions about a year later. We loved him so much that it was an easy decision to adopt him. On May 12th, 2023, my girls and I were overjoyed to finally know he would be part of our family forever. able to be united with two of his siblings that are with another Agape family. We have been blessed to get to know them all and look forward to allowing the kids to grow up together.

My son's mom and I have been able to connect through Messenger and I am loving being able to get to know her and share his photos and milestones. My hope is that he will always get to hear directly how much he is loved by not only our family but his biological family as well.

I will be forever grateful to the Agape staff, especially our social worker, Brian, for supporting us every step of the way. There was never a moment that I felt lost in the process. Brian, Nina and Lisa were always just a quick text or email away. I even had to move my family during this time and they helped me make the process as easy as possible, getting all the documents updated and the new house certified. Brian also helped get my son the extra services he needed and always made sure there was nothing we were in need of at all during his weekly visits. I can't imagine going through this process without our Agape Villages family.



The Legacy of a Christian Mother From the President, Janet Kleyn


